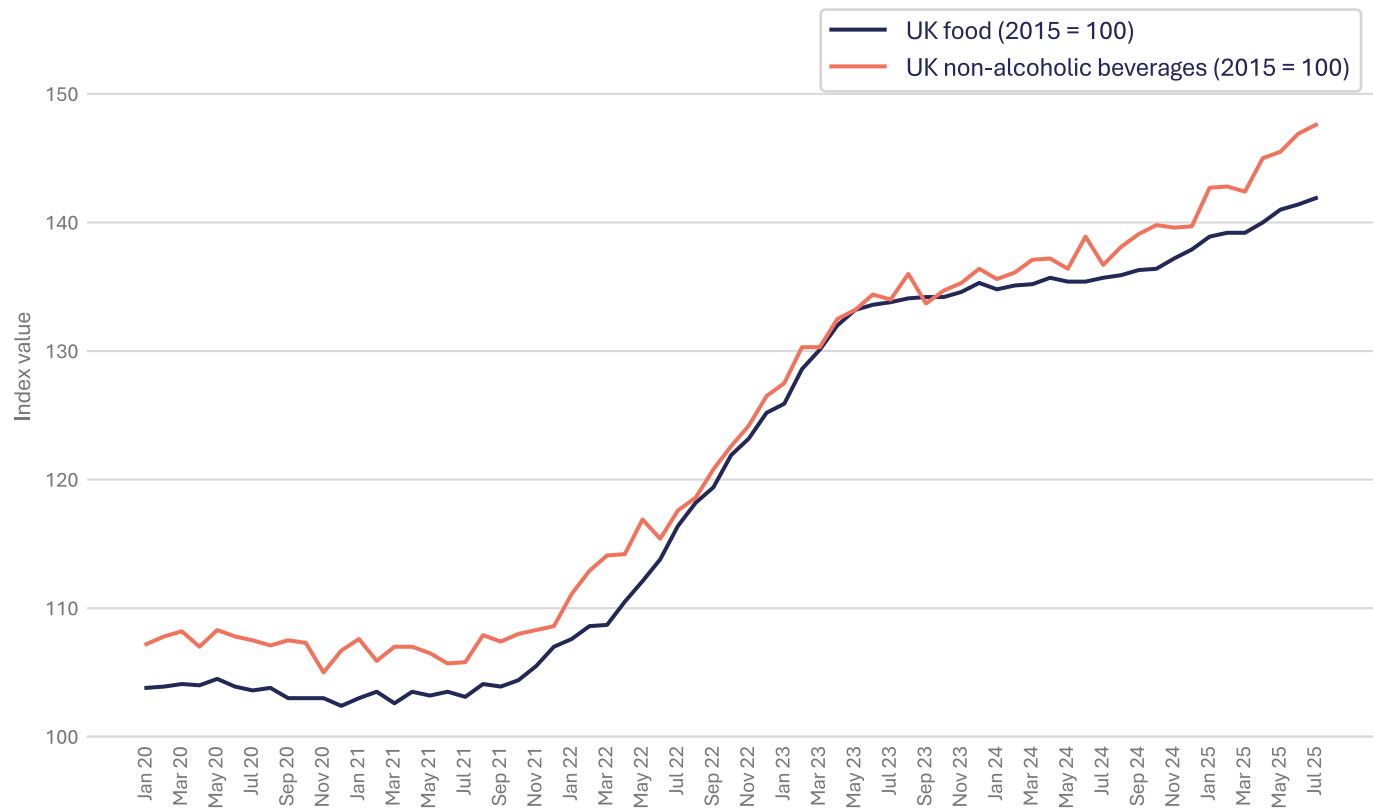

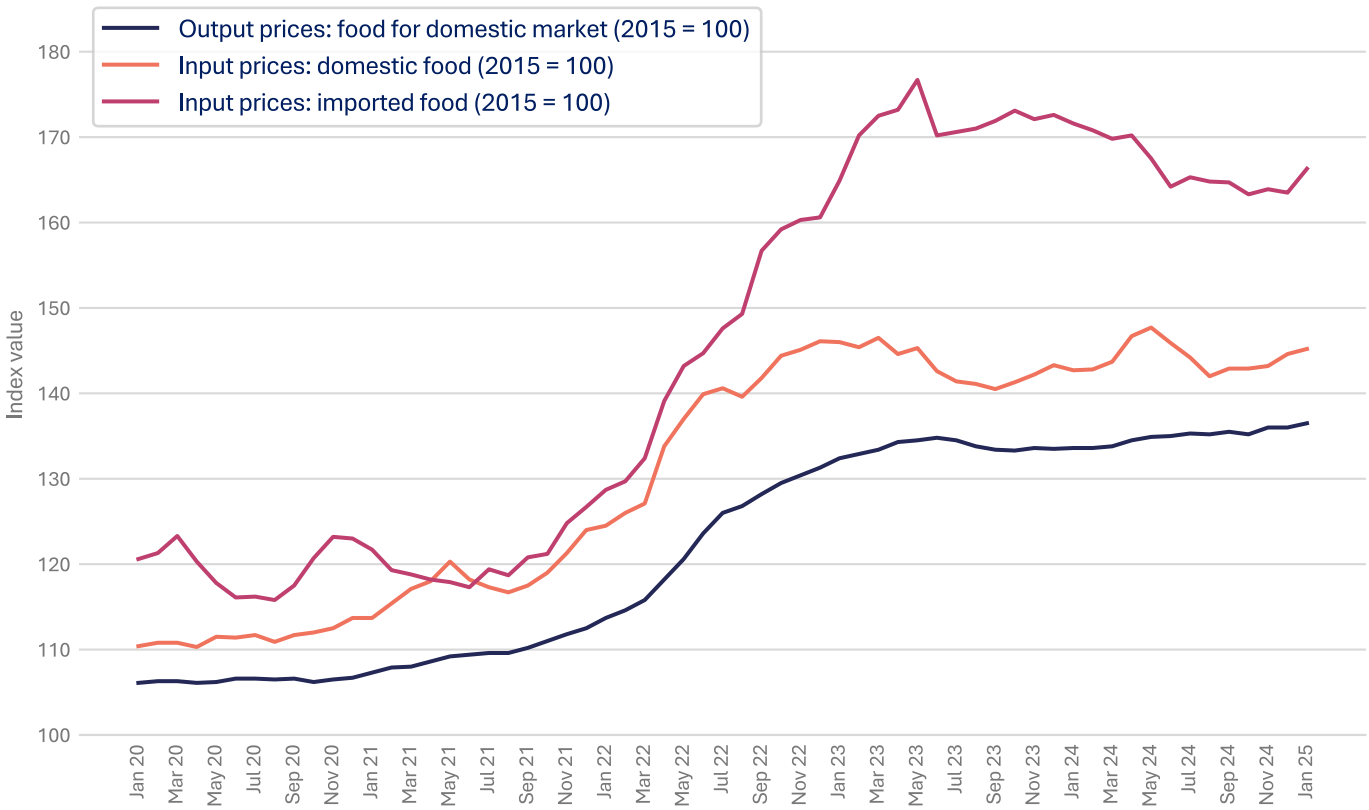

UK food and non-alcoholic drink inflation (CPIH)



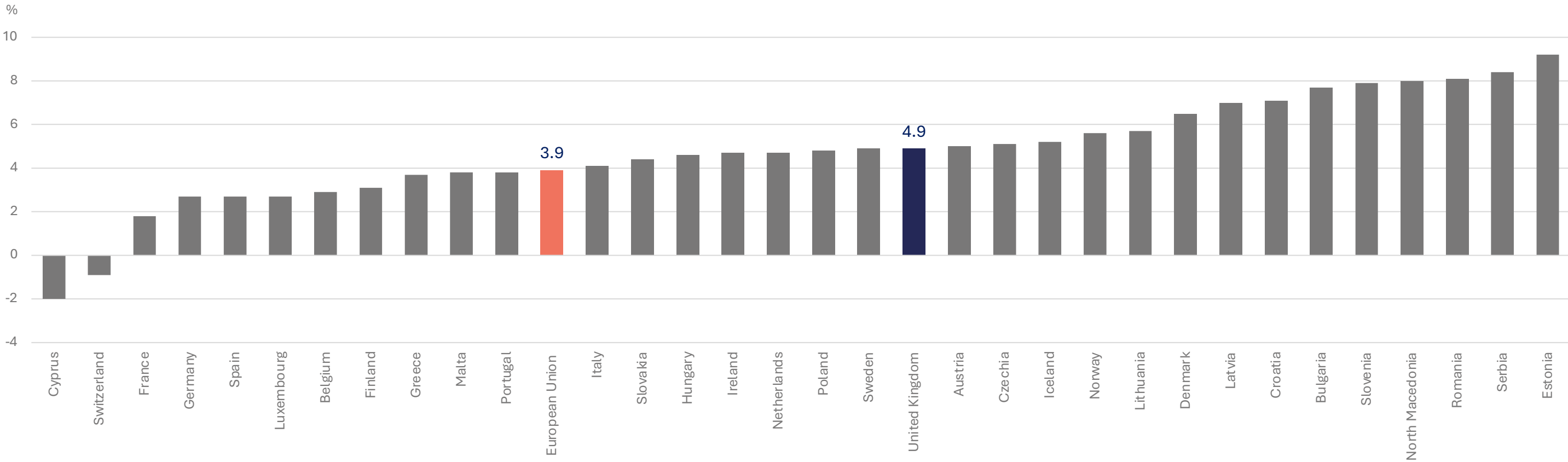

UK producer prices (PPI)



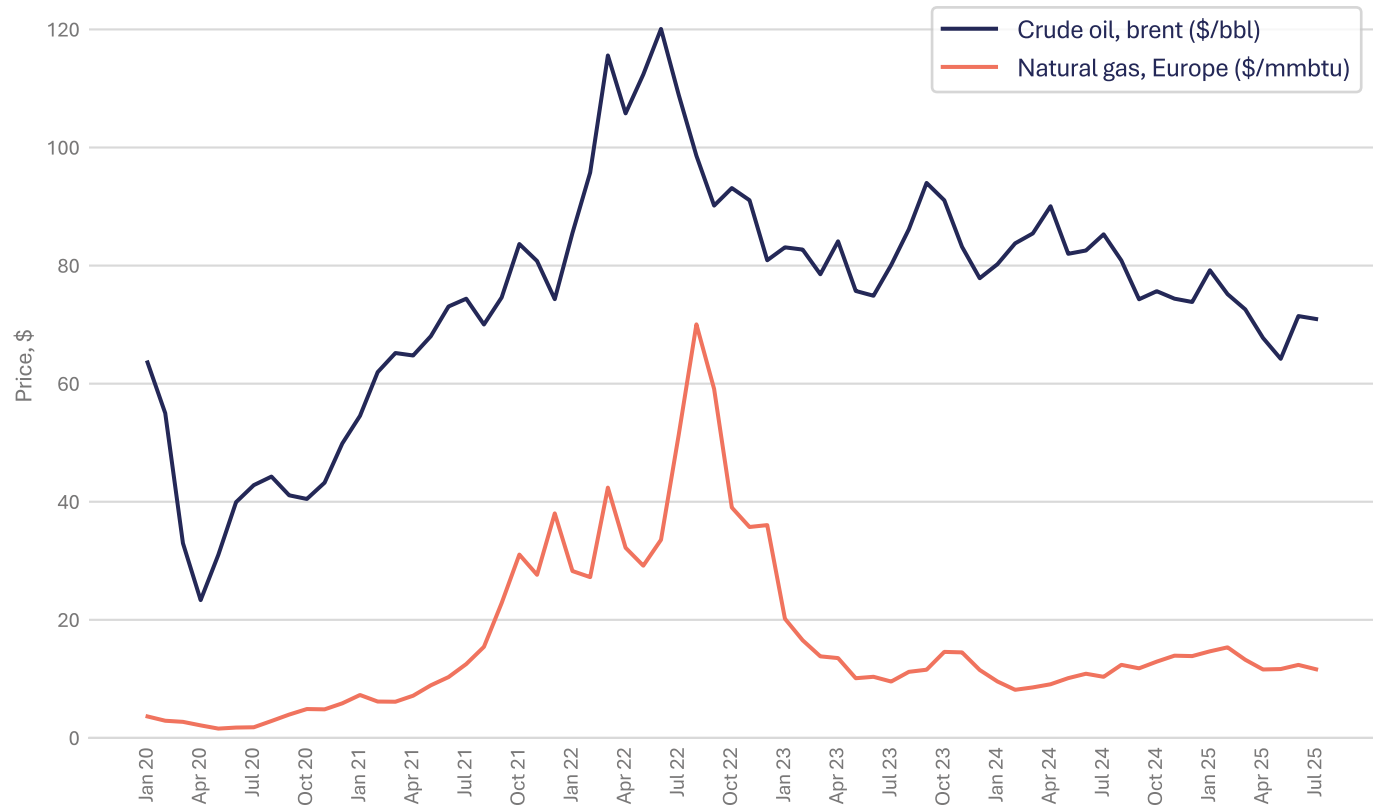

Food and non-alcoholic drink inflation comparison with Europe (annual rate of change, July 2025)



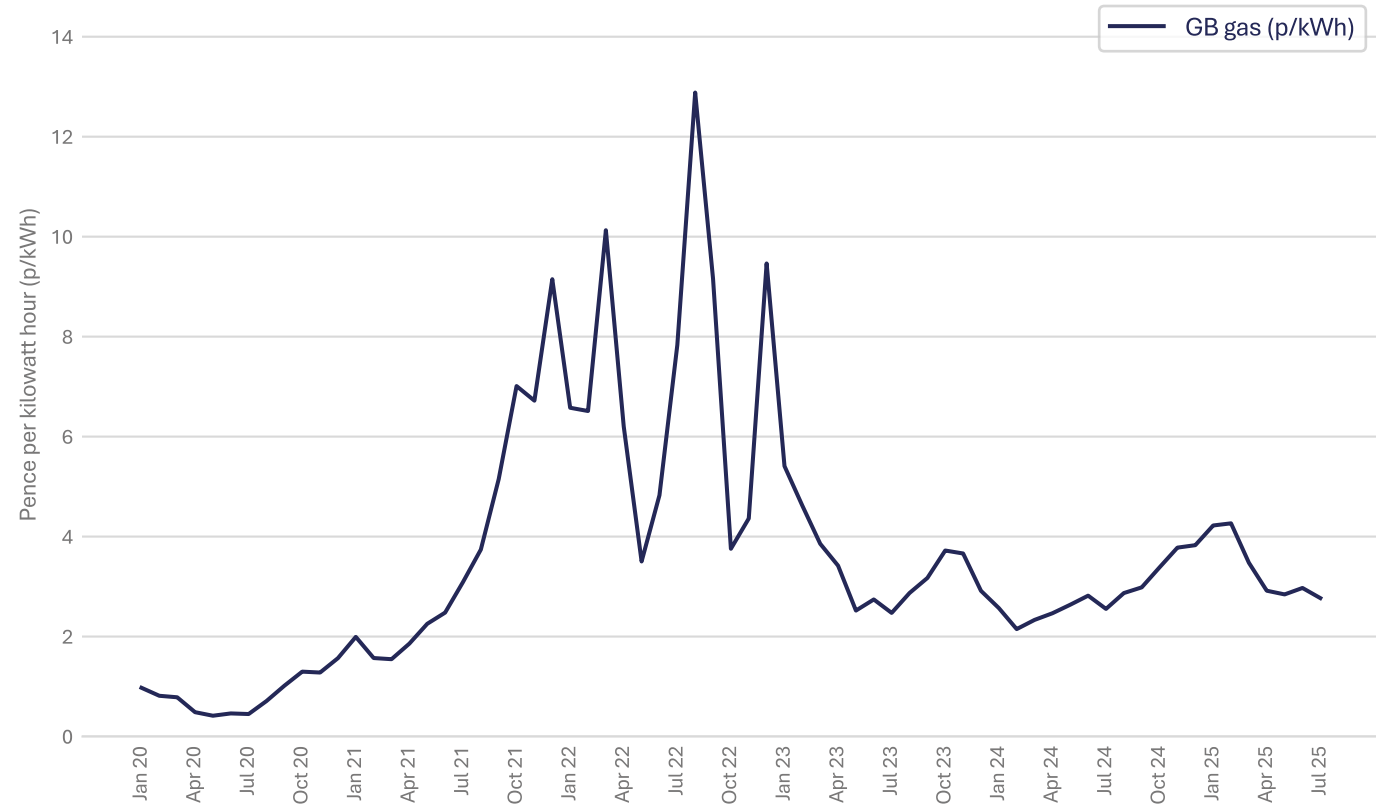

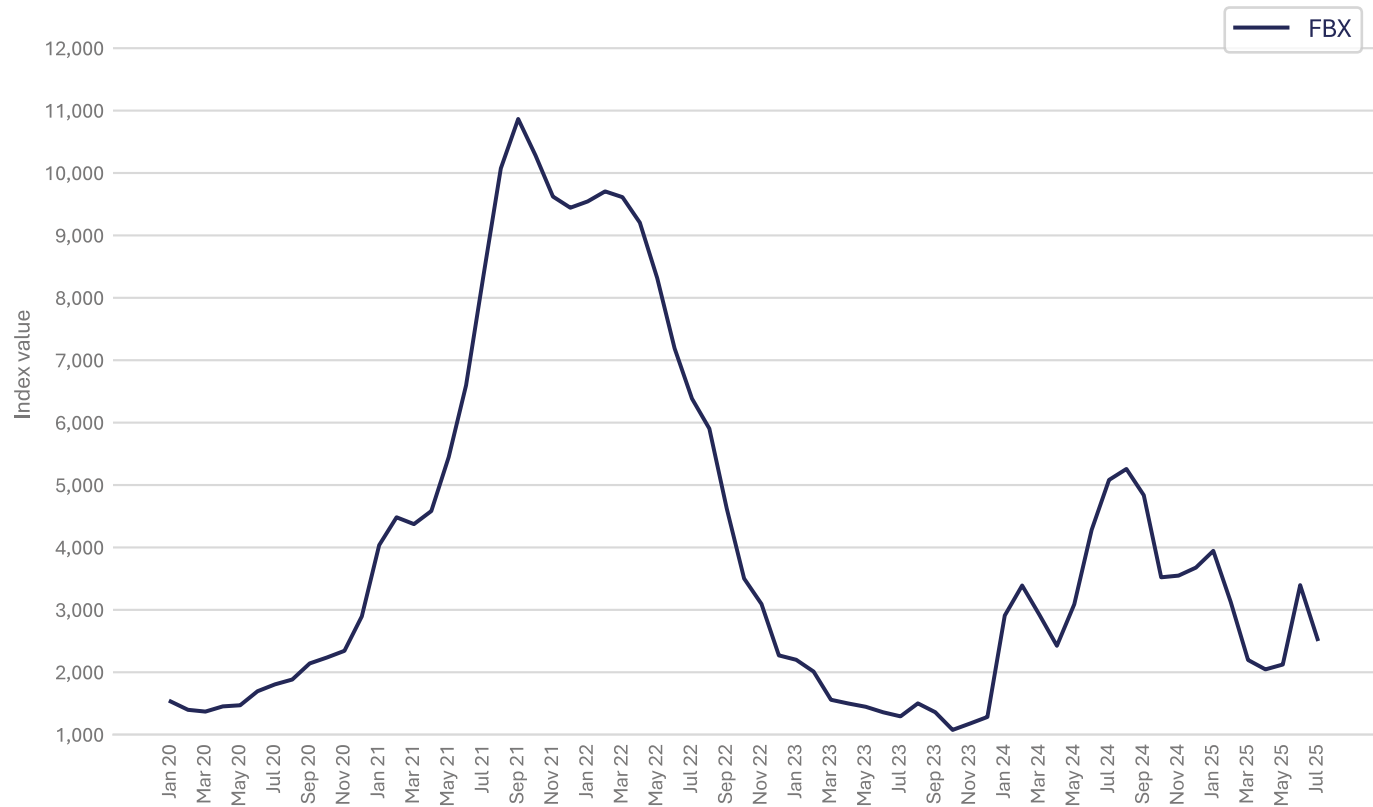

Monthly system average price (SAP) of gas



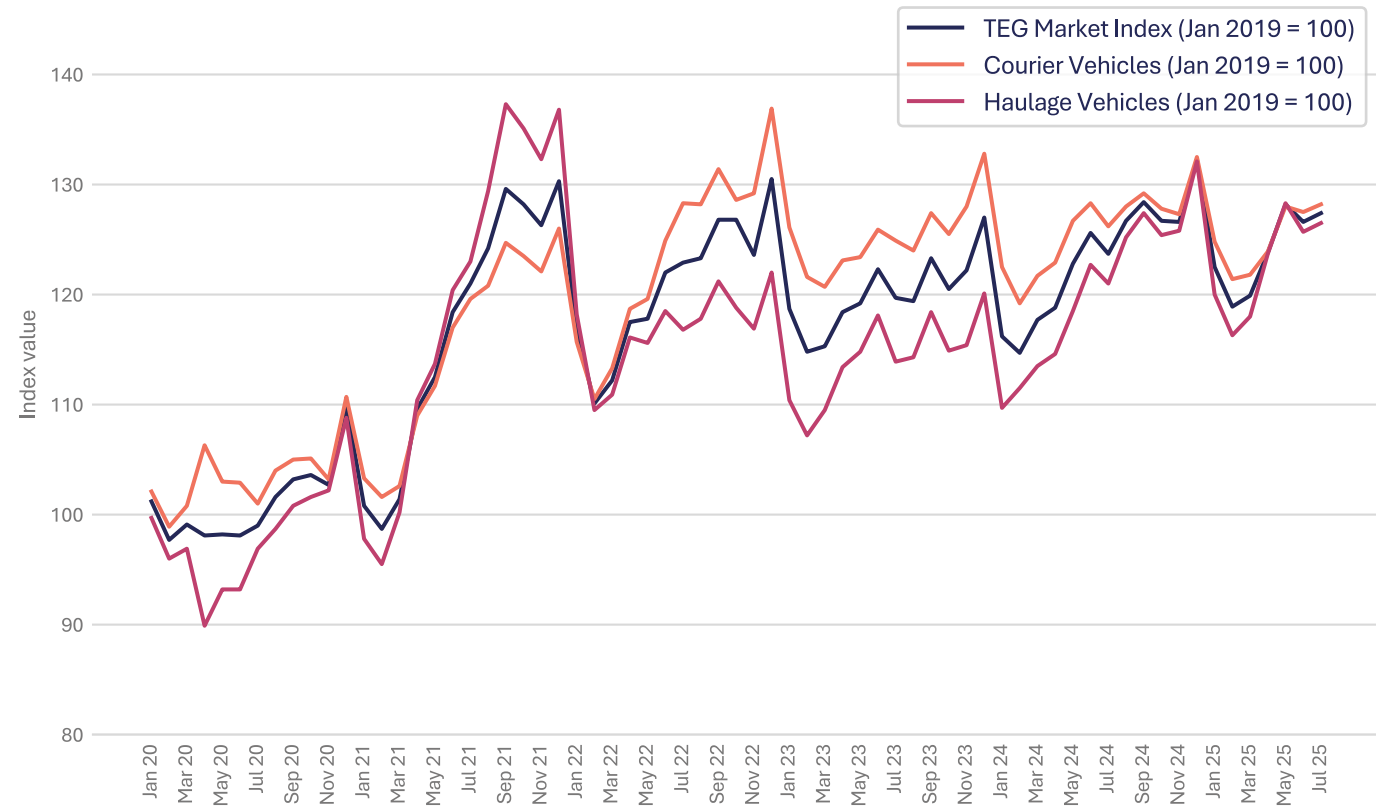

Freightos Baltic Index (FBX): Global Container Freight Index



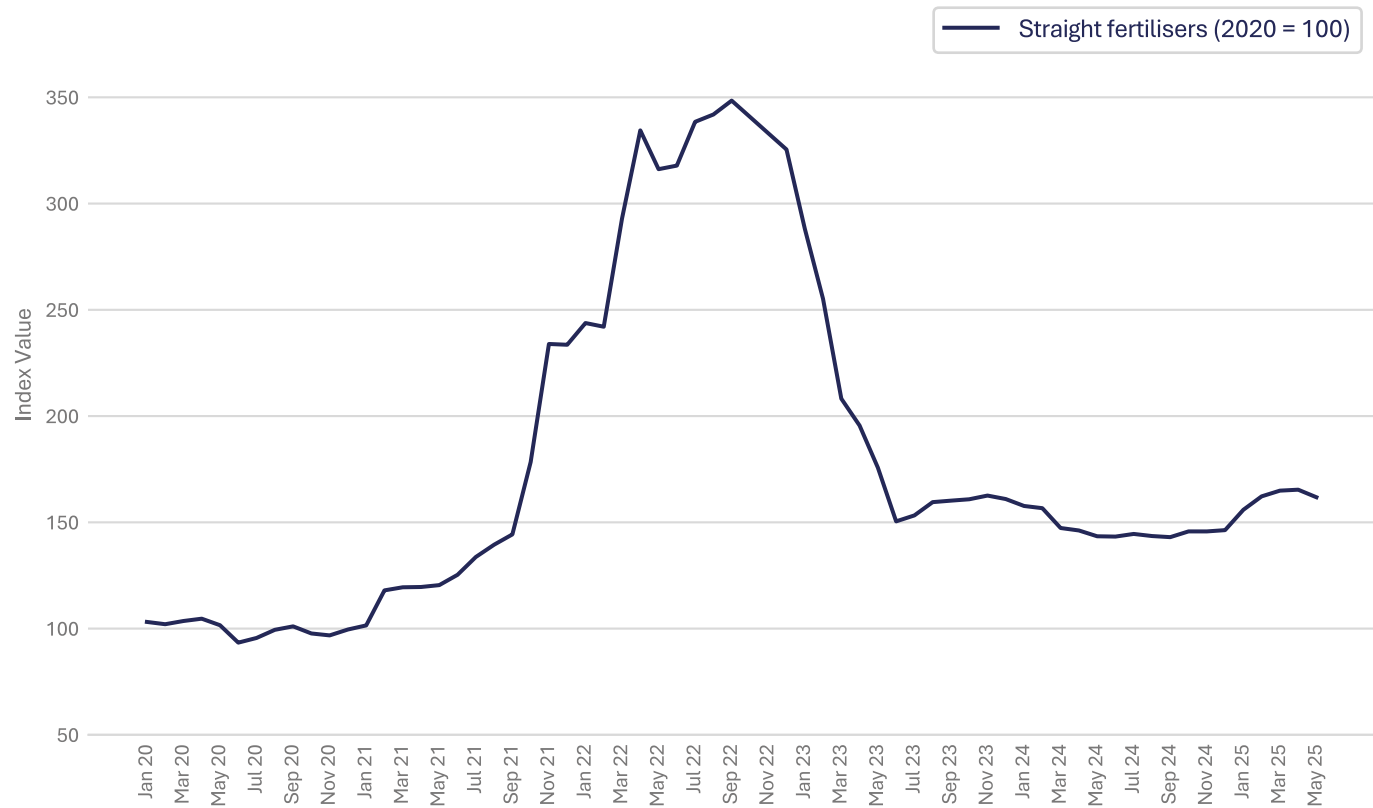

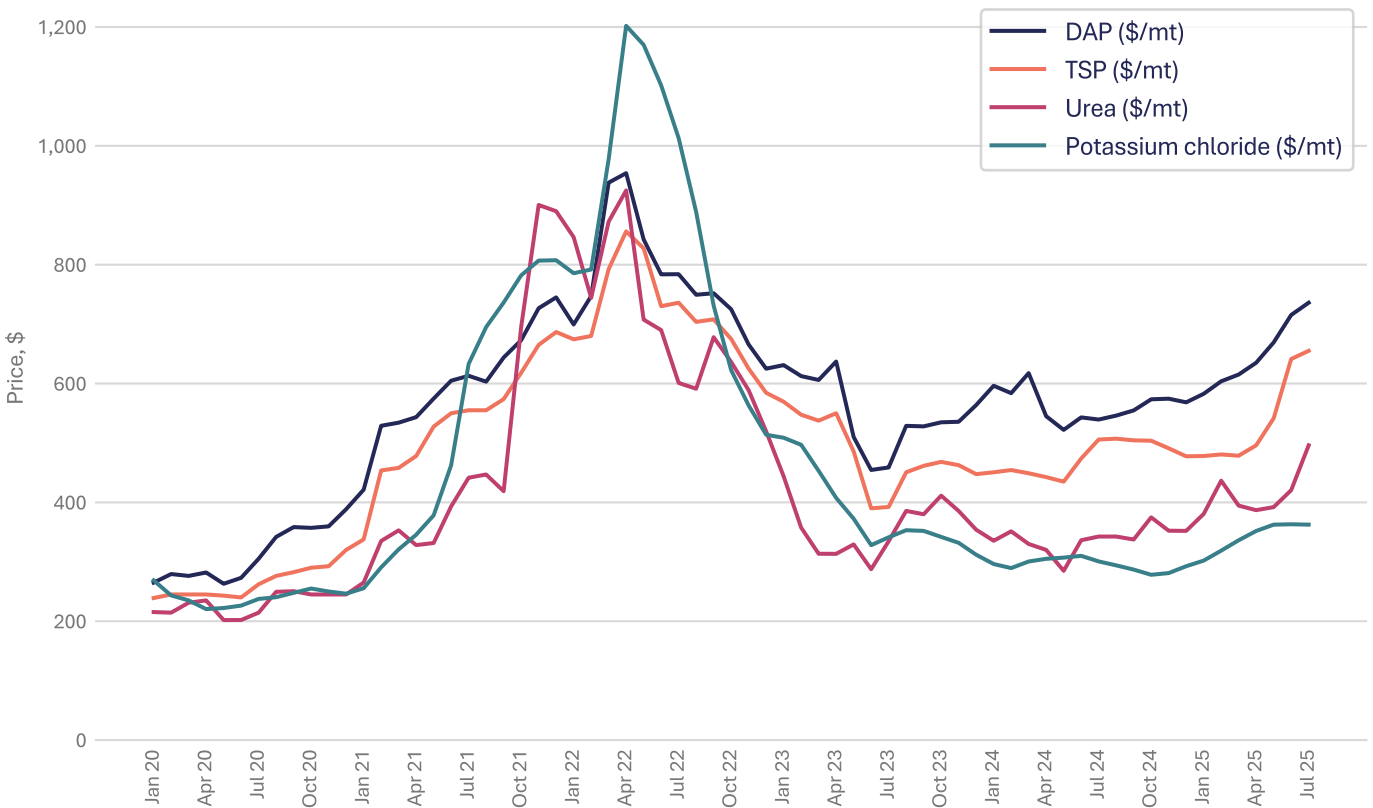

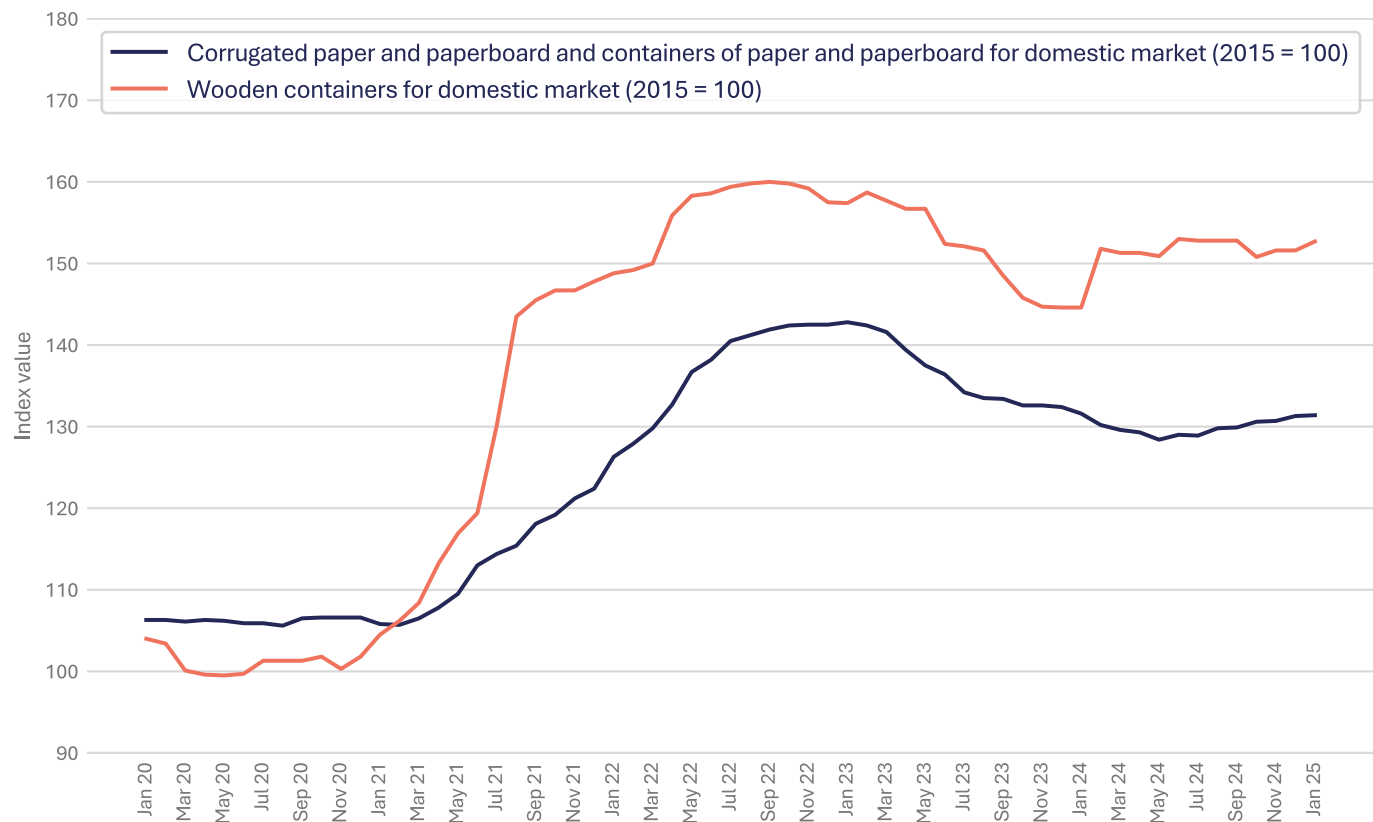

DAP, TSP, Urea and Potassium Chloride



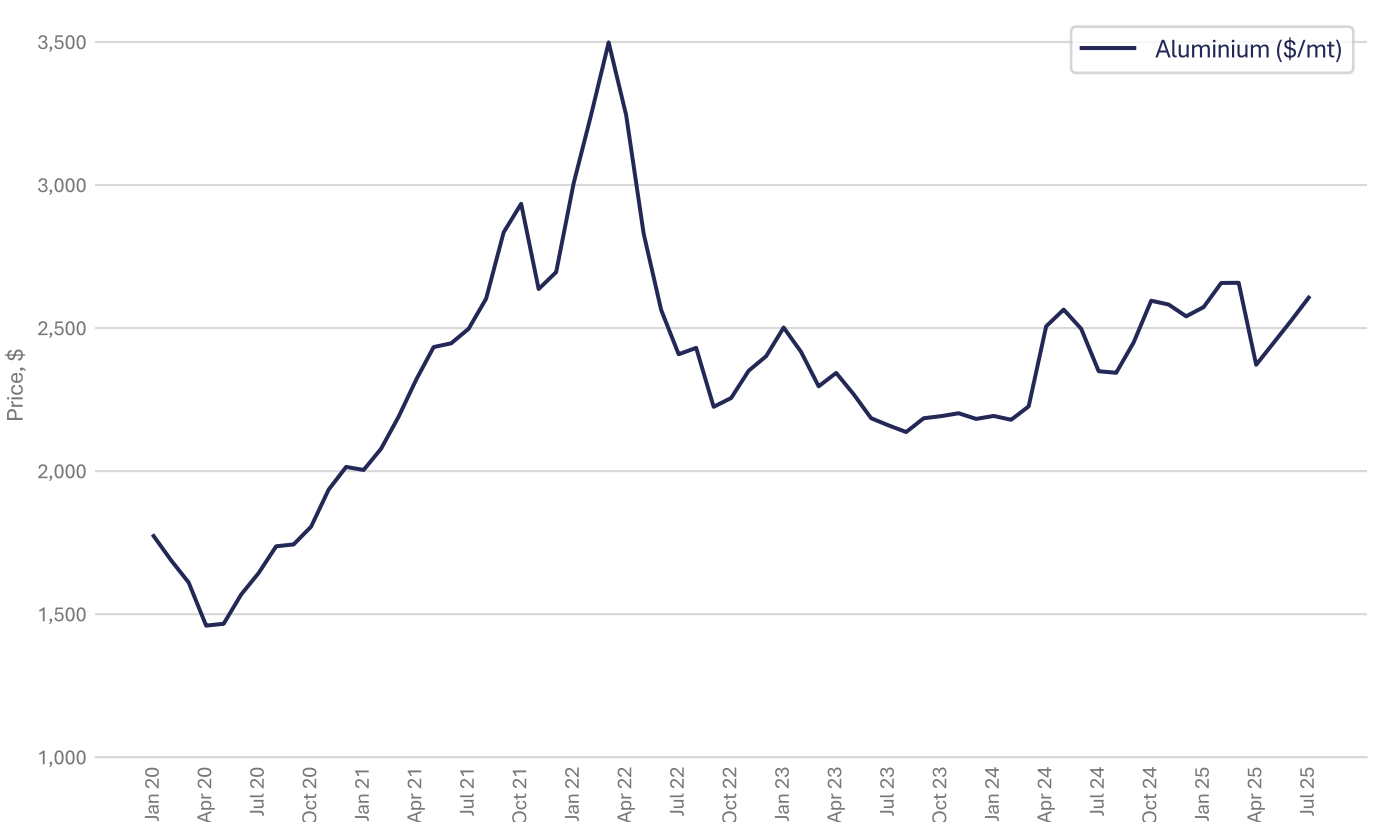

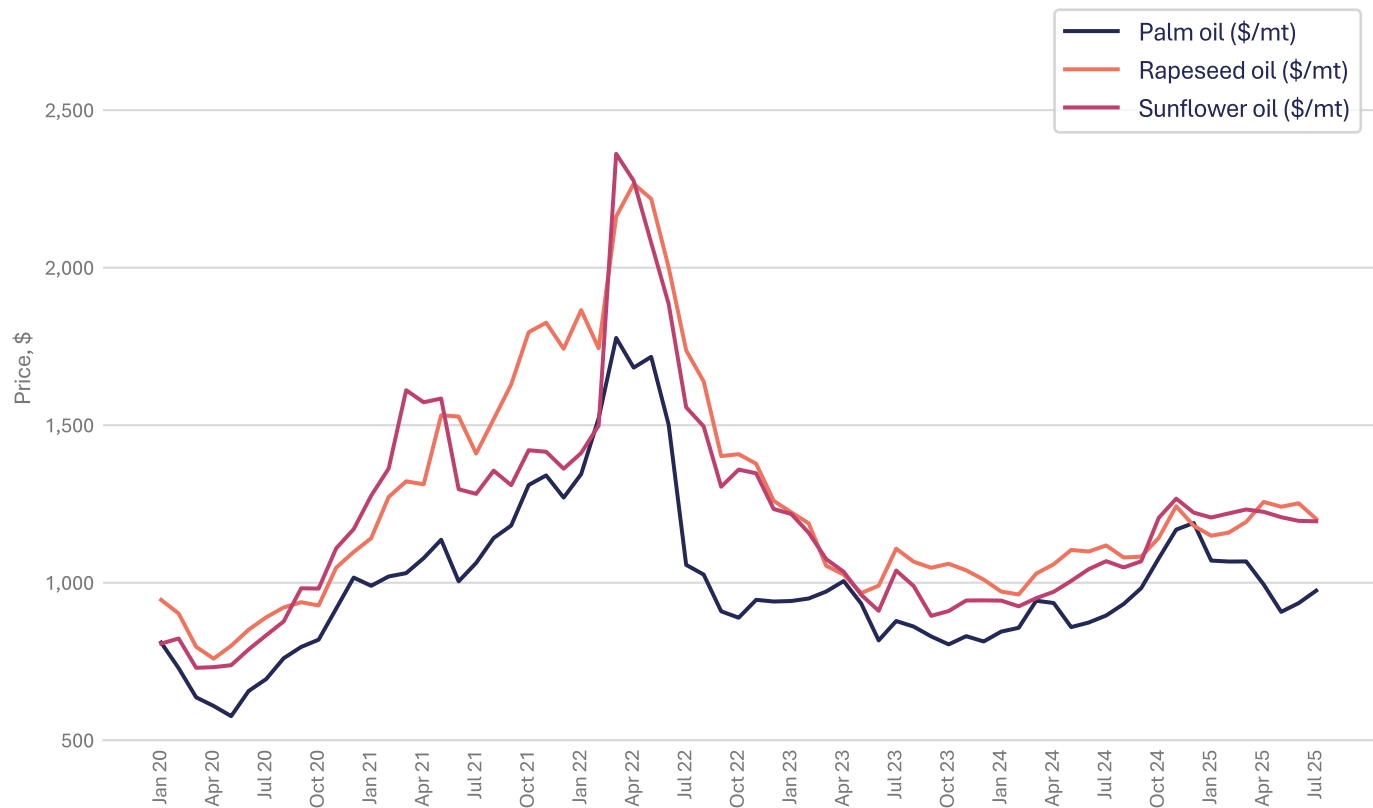

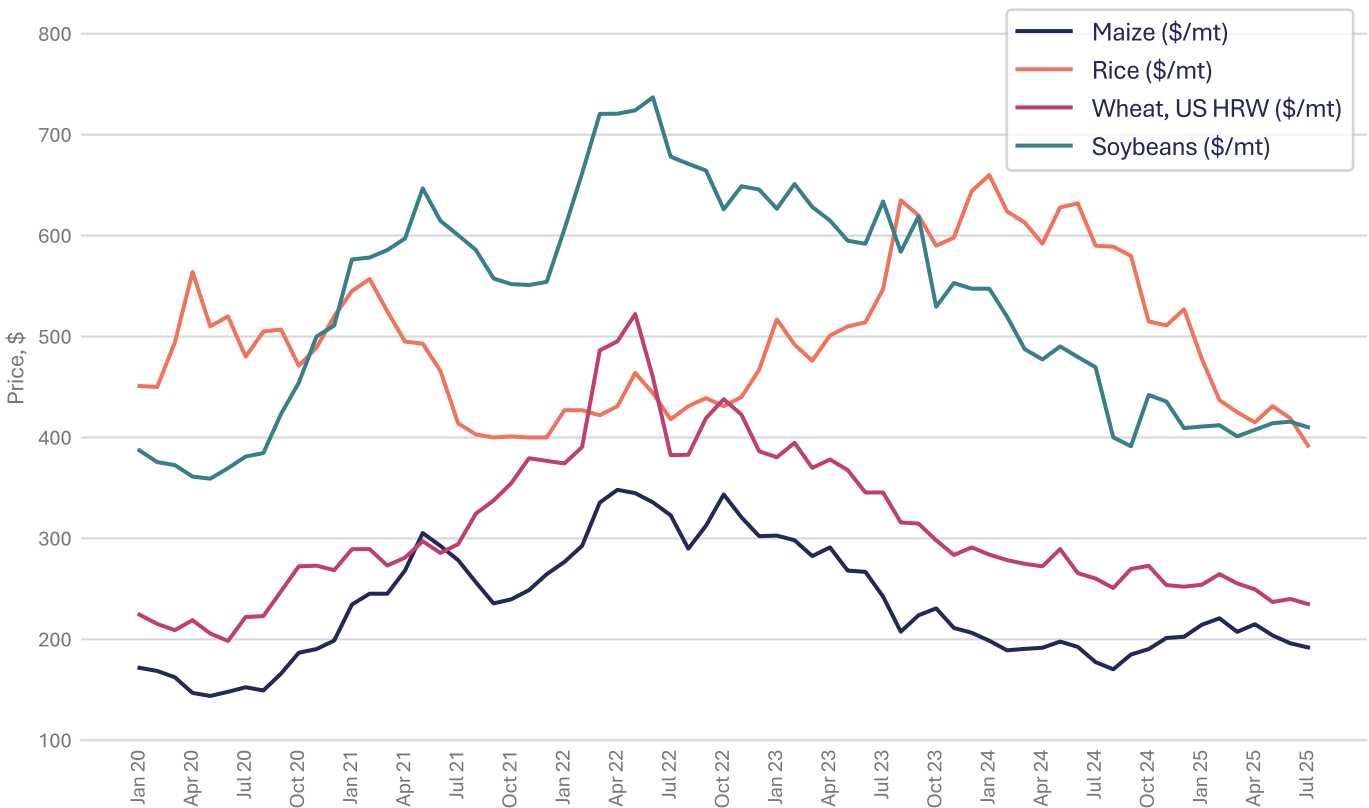

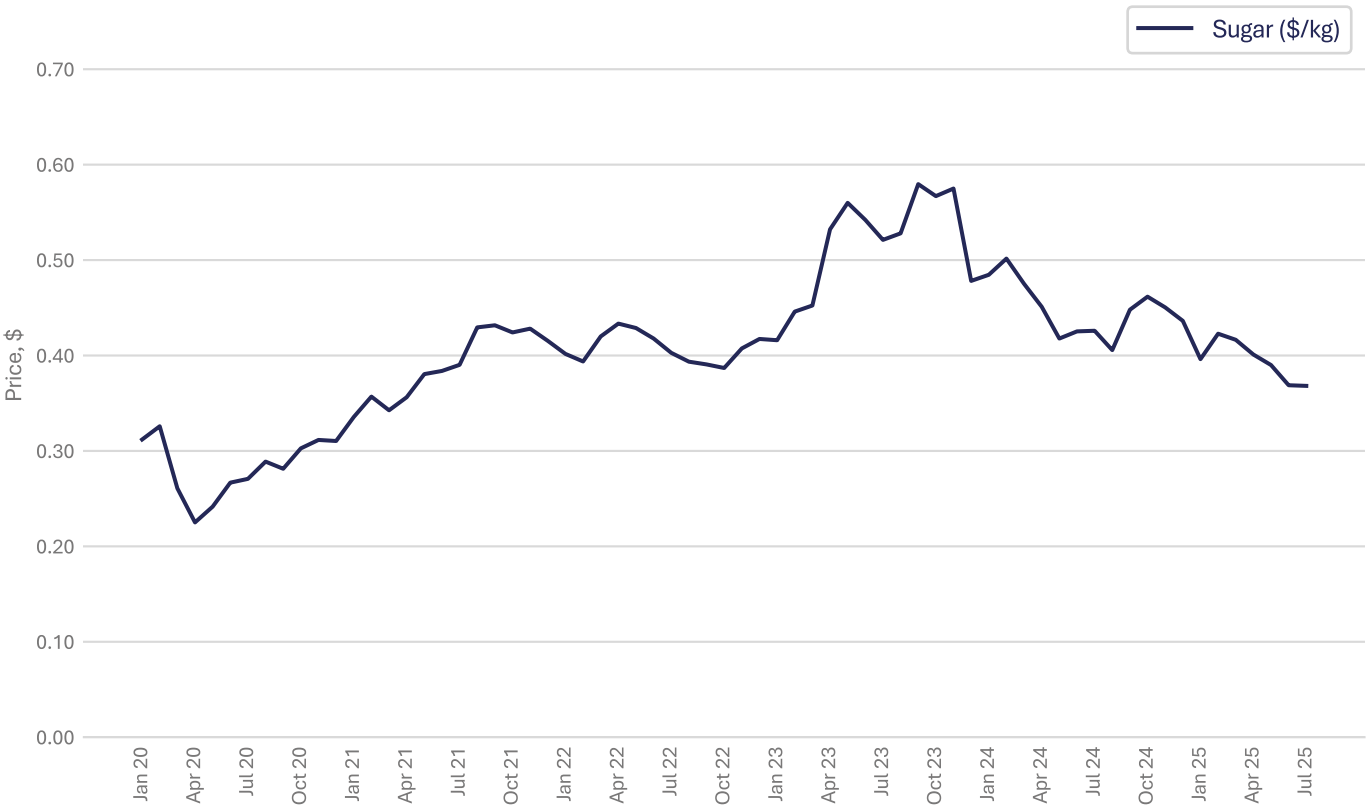

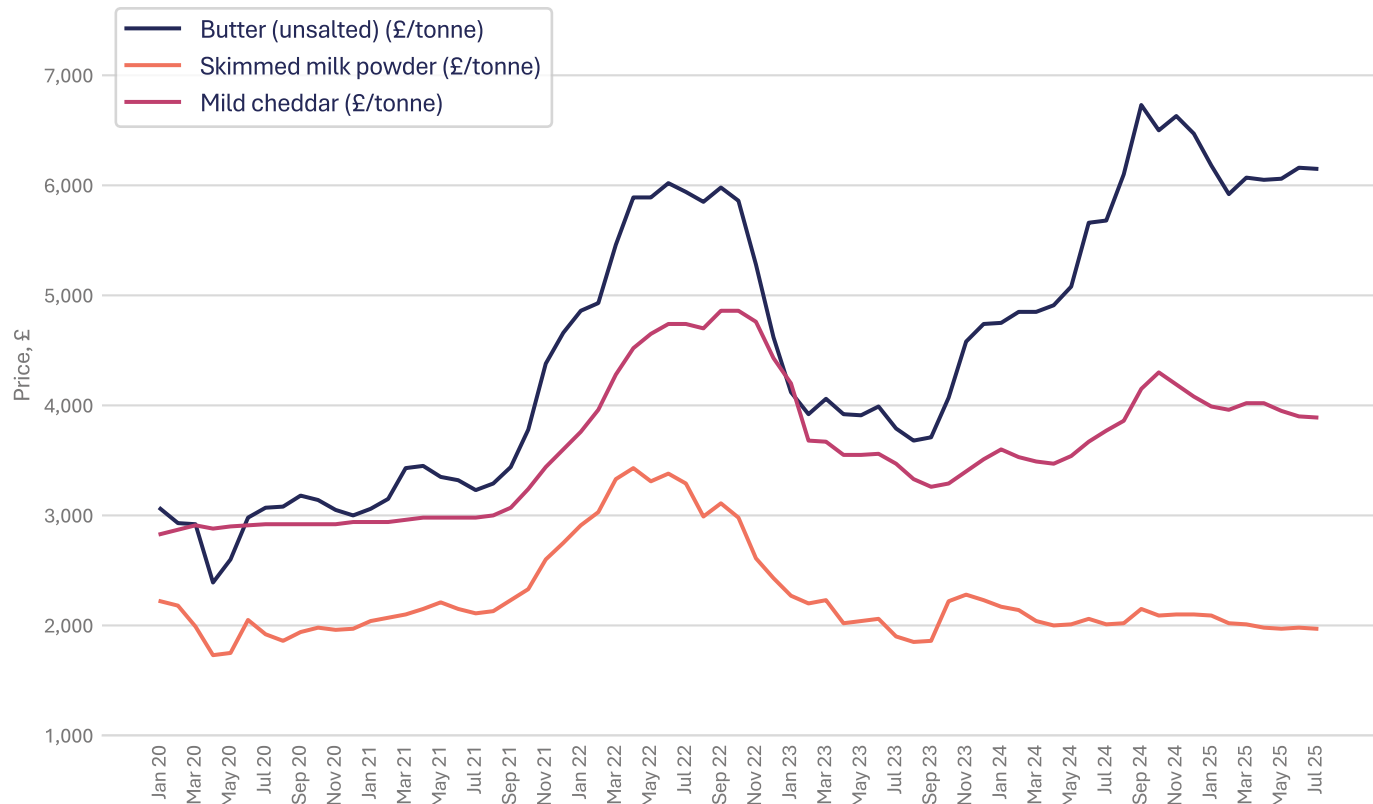

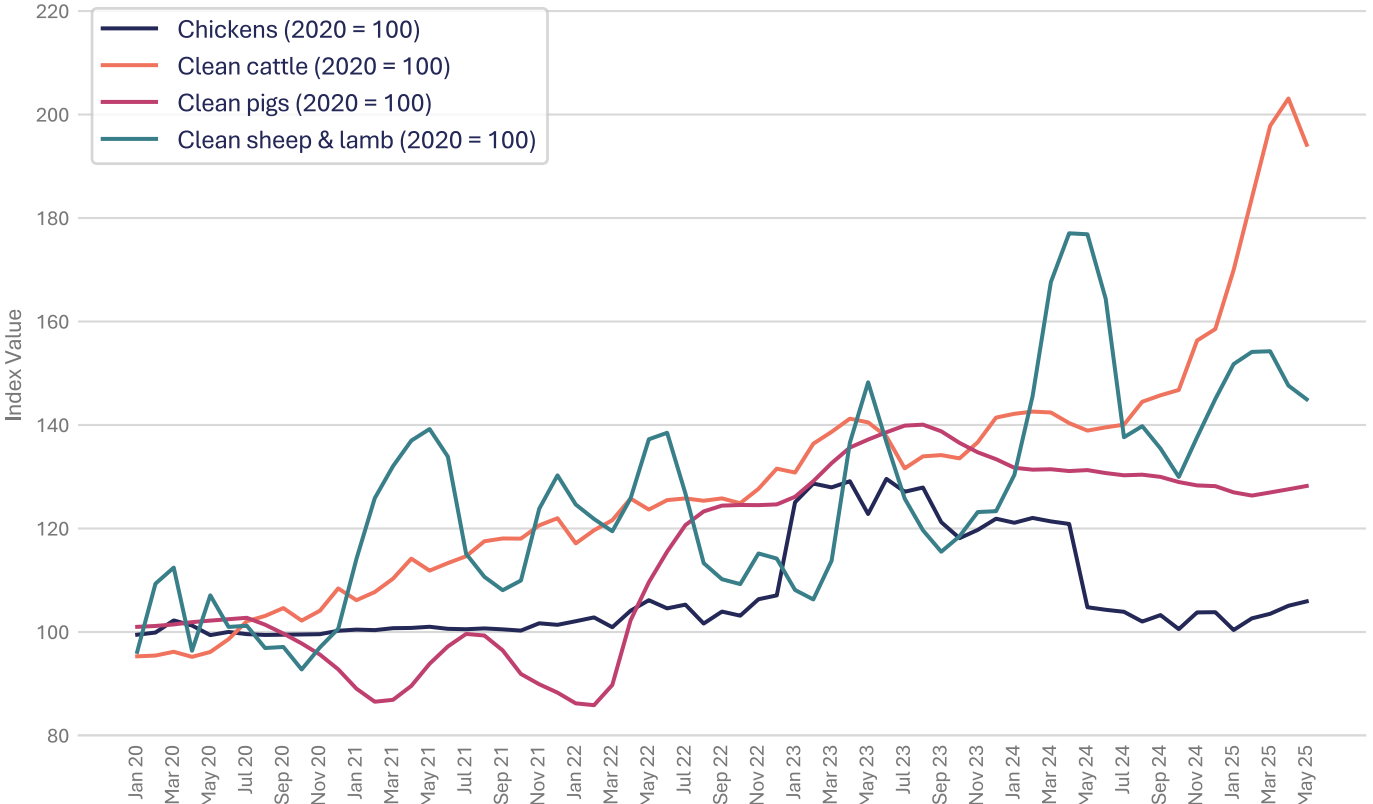

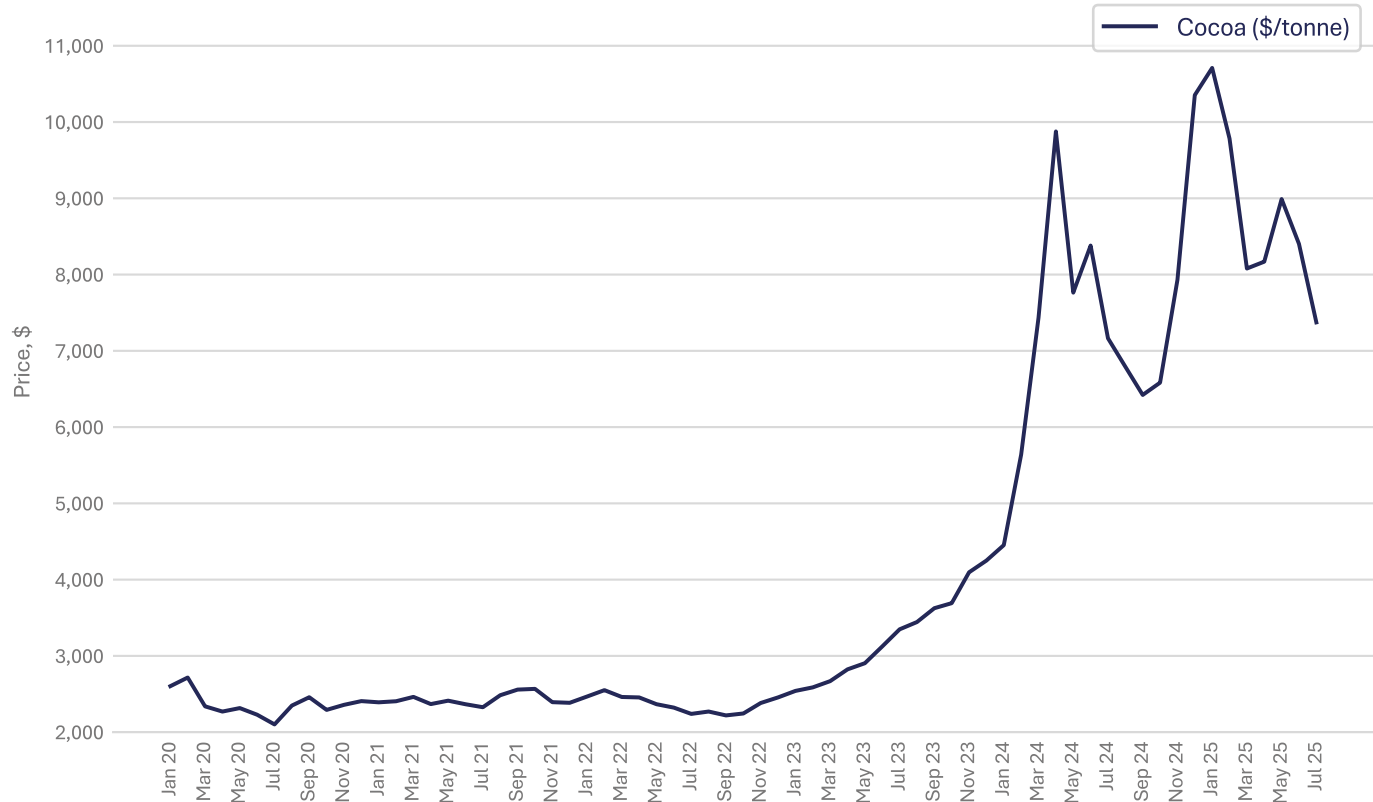

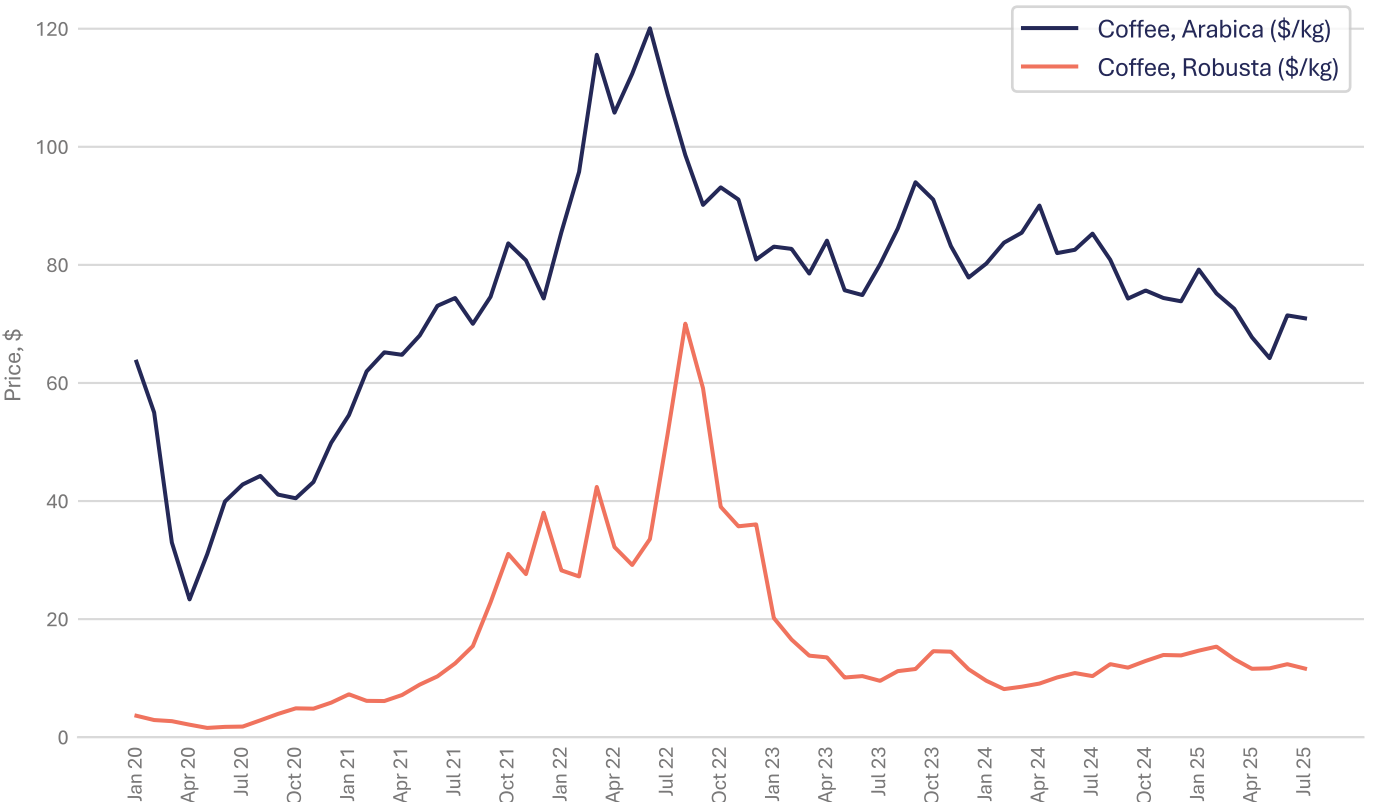

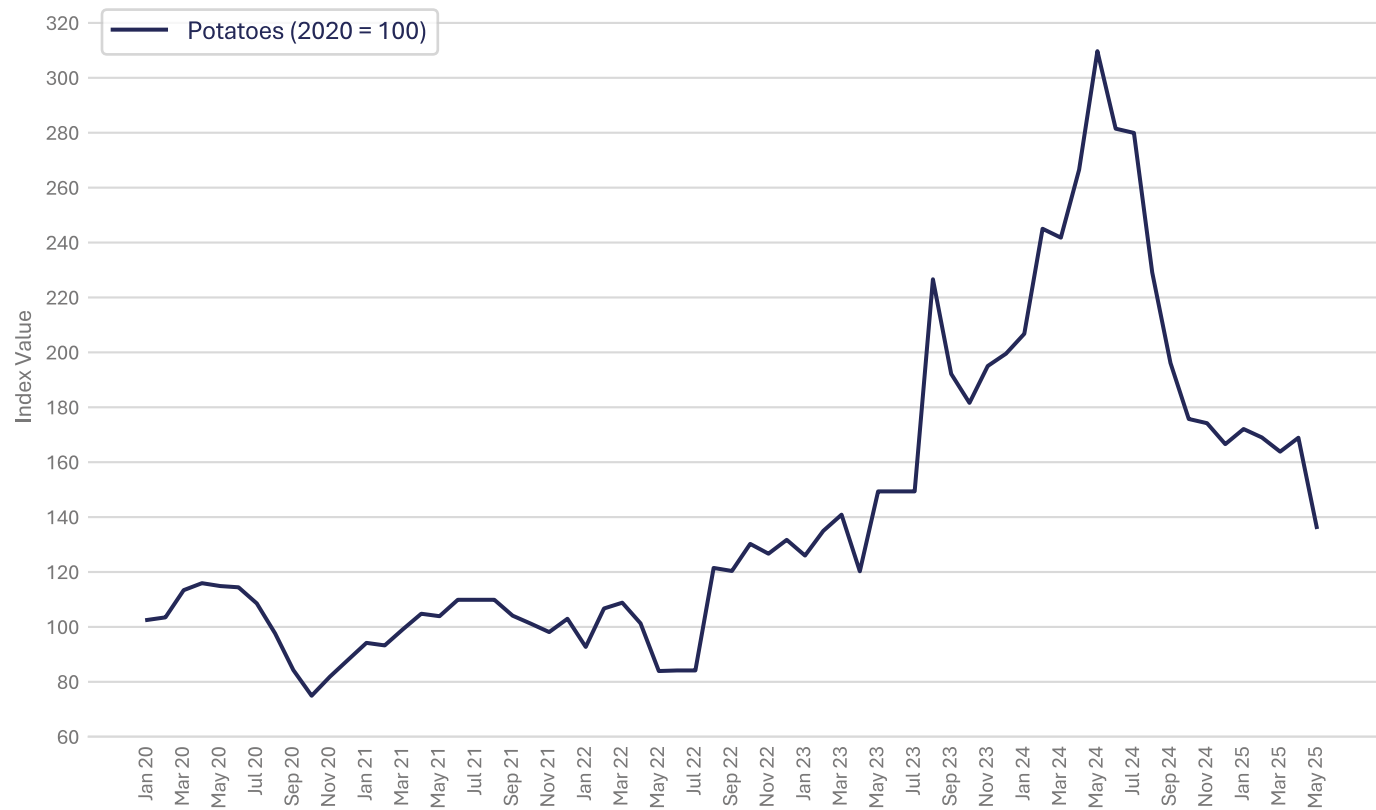

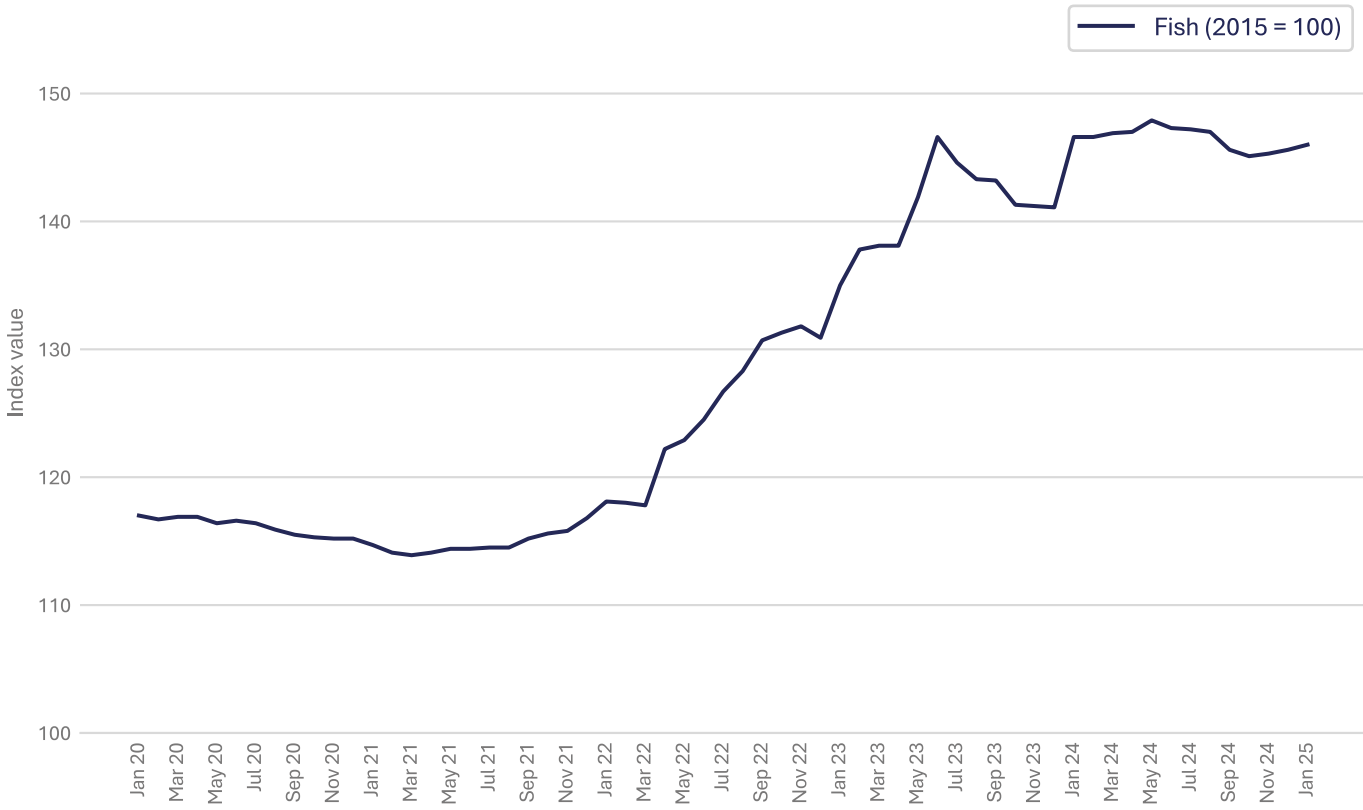
