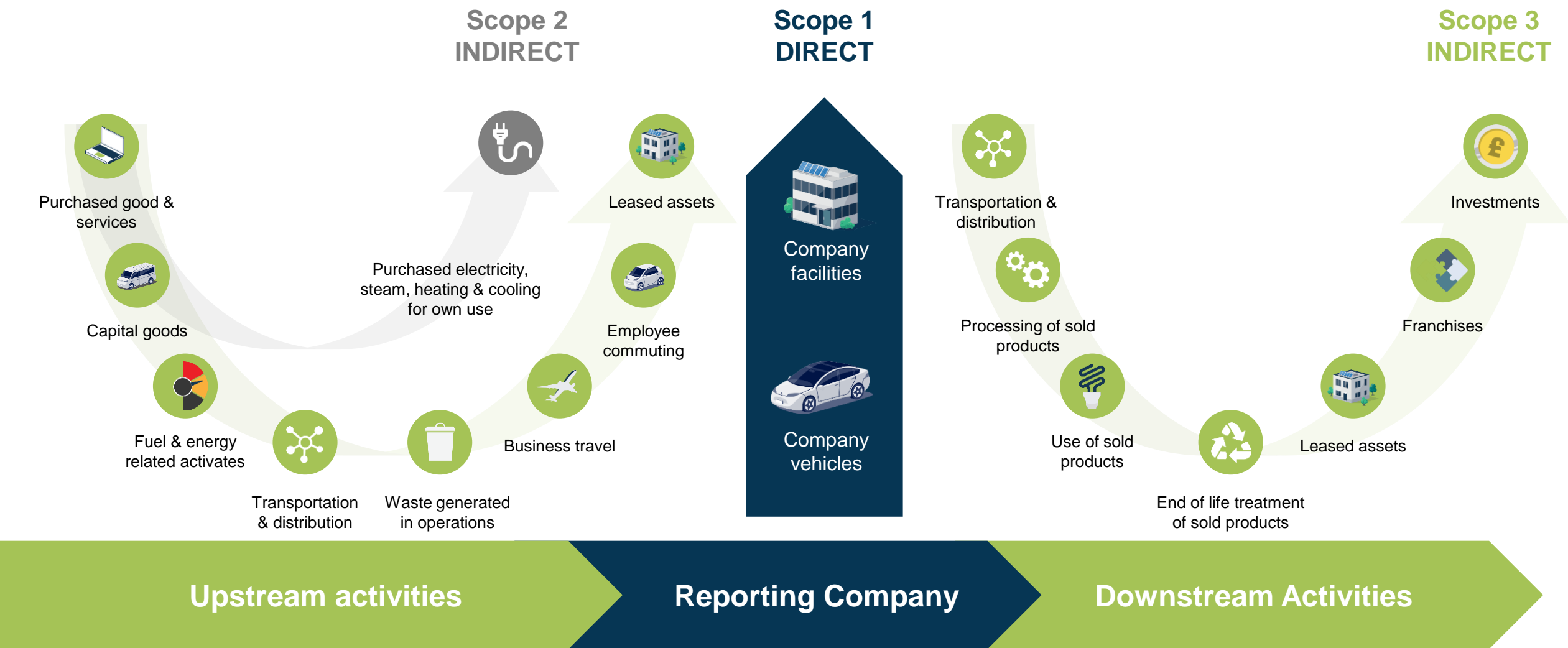

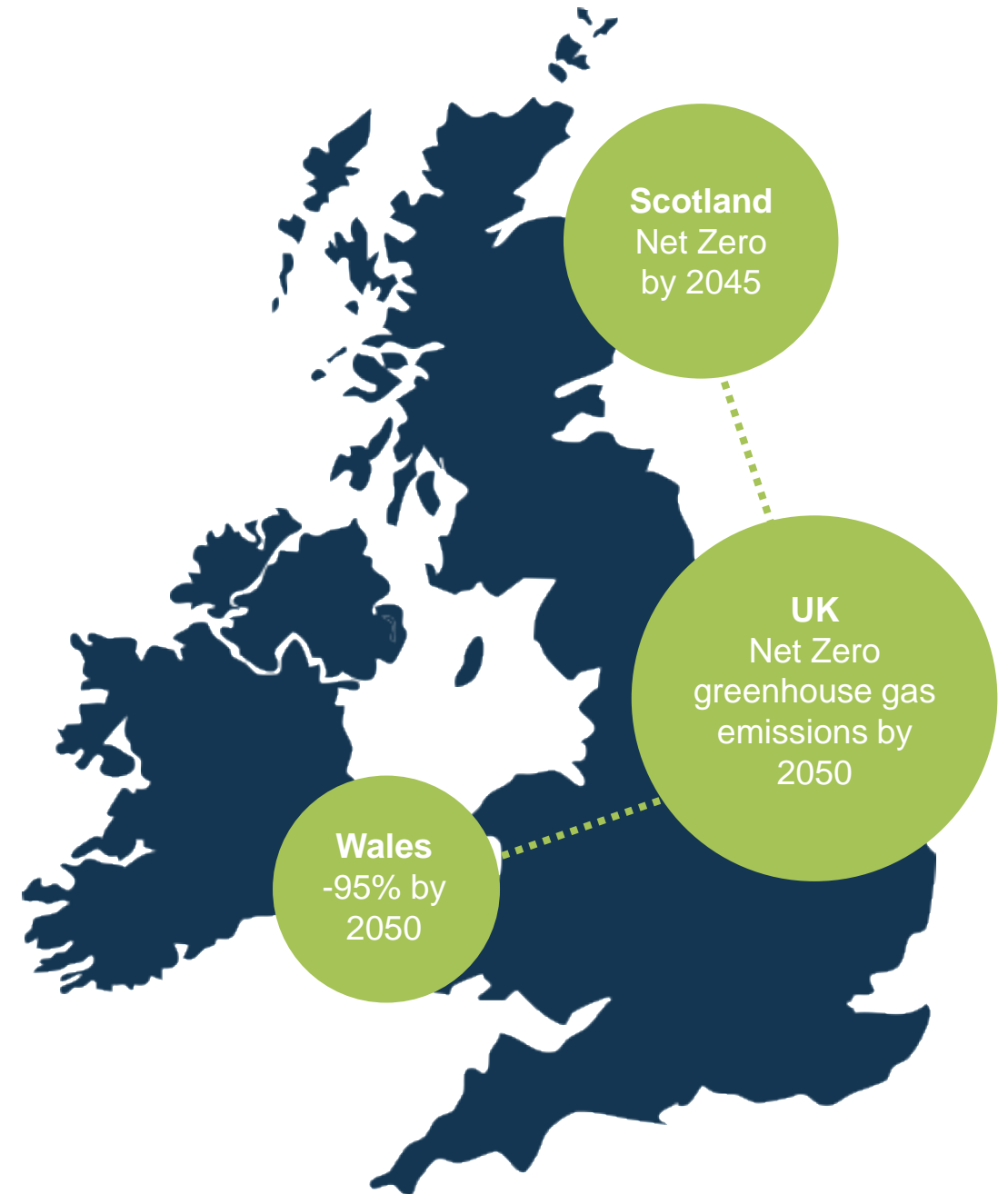

UK regulations and how they affect UK businesses

The Environment Agency's road map aims to cut the UK's carbon emissions by 45% by 2030

- The **Energy Savings Opportunity Scheme (ESOS)** requires large organisations in the UK to undertake mandatory assessments every four years looking at energy use and energy.
- The **Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting Regulation (SECR)** makes it mandatory for large businesses in the UK to annually report on their energy and carbon emissions as well as any efficiency measures.

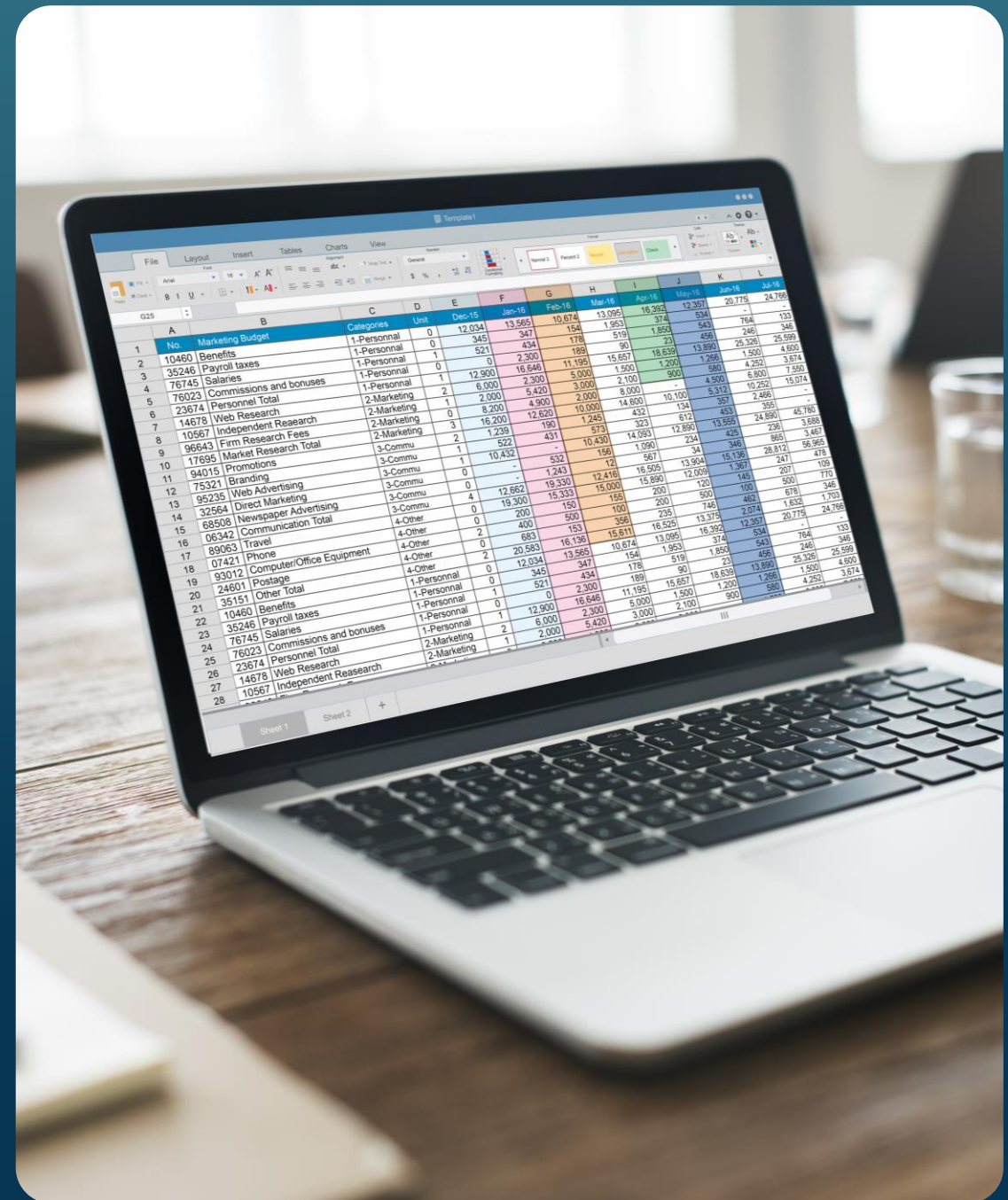
